Abita Purple Haze - a crisp, American style wheat beer with raspberry puree added after filtration. Therefore, you may see raspberry pulp in the beer. The raspberries provide the lager with a subtle purple coloration and haze, a fruity aroma, and a tartly sweet taste. **\$3.75**

Abita Turbodog - a dark brown ale brewed with Willamette hops and a combination of pale, crystal and chocolate malts. This combination gives Turbodog its rich body and color and a sweet chocolate toffee-like flavor. This ale pairs well with most meats and is great served with hamburgers or sausages. **\$3.75**

Boulder Beer Sweaty Betty Blonde - has a light banana and spicy aroma, pretty faint. This is an easy to drink beer, crisp and refreshing. **\$3.75**

Bud Light - introduced nationally in 1982, is brewed with a malt and hops ratio different from Budweiser for a crisp taste with fewer calories. **\$3.25**

Pabst Blue Ribbon - originally called Best Select, the current name came from the blue ribbons that were tied around the bottle neck, a practice from 1882 until 1916. It's the kind of beer that never fills you up, and this makes it an ideal choice for pre- and post-meal guzzling. Most important, PBR was (and is) cheap. And never let anyone tell you life is too short to drink cheap beer. **\$2.00**

Highland Gaelic Ale - a deep amber colored American ale, featuring a rich malty body. This ale is exceptionally balanced between malty sweetness and delicate hop bitterness. **\$3.75**

Highland St. Therese's Pale Ale - a golden pale ale having a slightly malty body balanced by an assertive American hop flavor. A crisp and refreshing beer perfect for any occasion. **\$3.75**

Rogue Dead Guy Ale - a German-style Maibock made with Rogue's proprietary "PacMan" ale yeast. It is deep honey in color with a malty aroma, rich hearty flavor and a well balanced finish. **\$4.50**

Sierra Nevada Porter - dark and rich, it is a delicious, medium-bodied ale with a creamy head. The Porter's smooth flavor (malty with hints of caramel) comes from a blend of deep-roasted barley malts. **\$3.75**

Yazoo Dos Perros Ale - toasty malt flavors go great with barbeque, grilled salmon, caramelized onions, and most hot and spicy foods. **\$3.75**

Yazoo Pale Ale - the bracing bitterness of this beer can hold its own with spicy foods, while helping to cleanse the palate after rich, creamy dishes. The citrus hop flavors go exceptionally well with any dishes using cilantro, such as Mexican salsas. **\$3.75**
